Thank you also to our judge Ari Norris. Originally from Muskegon, Michigan, Norris is an artist primarily working in sculpture, utilizing a variety of processes and materials. He received his MA from Northern Illinois University in 2021 and has exhibited solo shows in Chicago at David Salkin Creative, and the PLAN. Norris has been included in exhibitions *West, Wester, Westest 4* at Left Field, Los Osos, CA, *Shooting Pool with a Rope*, at Baby Blue Gallery, Chicago, IL, the *Midwest Sculpture Exhibition* in Kokomo, IN, and other locations including Michigan, New York, Florida, Texas and Gyeonggi-do, South Korea. In the fall of 2023, Norris completed his largest bronze commission, a 12-foot tall marching band major titled, *"Band Together,"* in Muskegon Heights, MI.
